Entry Deadline	Forms, Written Entries & Artwork must be delivered or emailed by March 20, 2024
Requirements for Visual Art	Dimensions of art not to exceed 18" X 24" , 2-Dimensional art only (3-D art and art reliefs will not be accepted) Submit unframed, one entry per student. Art must be original in creation and content; no copies of other artists' work will be accepted. (Please pay particular attention to the SCI plagiarism policies.) Judges will evaluate entries based on theme interpretation, technique, creativity & originality. Accepted entries will be on display at the local showcase. 1 st & 2 nd Place Winners will advance to international competition electronically. A selection of entries may advance to Kingston, Ontario Teen Art Exchange (electronically - digital image, not original art)

Requirements for Literature: Essay or Poetry	Writing may be an essay, maximum of 500 words , or poetry, a maximum of 200 words , not exceed 25 lines, must be double-space typed in English, one entry per student. Judges will evaluate entries based on theme interpretation, composition, and grammar. All work must be original and inspired by the theme. Email Entry Form and digital copy of original essay or poetry to: info@scottsdalesistercities.com Winning entries will be on display at the local showcase.
Eligibility	Entrants must be ages 13-18 before April 1, 2024. Residents and/or students of Scottsdale and the surrounding area are eligible.
